S/3/1 Declaration Basis & Minimum Premium

The premium in respect of the Personal Accident section of this Policy is adjustable. First and Annual Premiums are provisional and will be adjusted annually based on the Insured's membership base. Adjusted premiums will be subject to a £50,036 minimum premium (excluding taxes) and any return premium on adjustment will not exceed this amount.

Definitions

The Operative Time for Category A Insured Persons is as follows:

Whilst accompanying a patient or travelling to attend a medical emergency anywhere in the world as a part of their occupation as a medical professional. Cover commences from the time the 'call out' is made to the Insured Person(s) and ceases when the Insured Person returns to their normal place of work, residence or location from which they received the 'call out'. Anaesthesia Associates who are members of the Association of Anaesthetists must be accompanied by a consultant anaesthetist to be operative.

S/4/1 Military Training

The Operative Time of this Policy extends to provide cover whilst an Insured Person is engaged in medical training courses with any armed forces of the United Kingdom

S/5/1 Secondary Retrieval

The Operative Time of this Policy extends to provide cover whilst an Insured Person is attending Secondary Retrieval training courses in the United Kingdom.
